Parent Orientation Evening Next Thursday 6:30

Forms & Fees Checklist coming home tomorrow

Please check your children's backpacks tomorrow as a checklist will be sent home with a list of the required and optional forms and fees that need to be completed. Most of our required documentation and all of our fees can be collected using your <u>School Cash Online</u> account, which is available on the front page of the <u>school website</u>. Please watch for the checklist with instructions and I ask that you complete the forms and fees as soon as possible.

Attendance Procedures Reminder

At the start of the year, it's worth a reminder about ensuring we are aware of your child's attendance for each day of school. Of course, we encourage students to be at school as much as possible, but if they are sick...like any of us, they should stay home. If students will be away, please use the <u>attendance report</u> <u>feature</u> accessible on the front page of the <u>school website</u>. If you are unable to access the website, please call the office after **8:00 am** at (604)942-0241 or send an email to <u>CoquitlamRiver@sd43.bc.ca</u> We ask that you inform us of any absences before 9:00 am so we can account for all of our students' whereabouts.



Drop off, pick up and traffic congestion

As we start off the year, let's all agree to start us off on a good foot – and good wheels – by following some really simple traffic rules that helps to keep everyone safe and moving. I'm sure you'll here about this a lot, but if everyone just abides by these *simple* rules, life is easier and safer for everyone.

• The *roundabout* loops at the front and back of the school are for quic drop off and pick up *only*. Call it *kiss and go* if that makes it easier to remember.

If you're planning to pick up your children at the end of the day, please tell your children to be waiting for you at the traffic loop so they can quickly get in the car and you can clear the loop for the parent waiting to come in

- Do not leave your car parked in the traffic loops to walk into the school grounds
- If you are walking your children to the classroom door, or waiting with them until the bell, *you must* park on Shaughnessy Street and walk with them onto the school grounds.
- **Do not** park along the fence next to the playground in the rear traffic loop. Drivers backing out of those spaces (which are reserved for daycare staff) poses a hazard to pedestrians and other drivers in the traffic loop. Again, the traffic loop is for drop off and pick up only.
- City by-laws require *right turn only* from 8:30-9:30 and 2:30-3:30. This also helps us to keep traffic moving smoothly
- **Do not** park or drop off/pick up in the staff parking lot. Our school staff has increased this year and we have a very limited number of spaces available. The parking lot adjacent to the school is reserved for school and district staff only

Following these simple protocols will allow for the safe, efficient movement of students and traffic as it enters and exits the property. Your cooperation is appreciated.
