**Mabels Labels-** go to [mabelslabels.ca](http://mabelslabels.ca) and click "support a fundraiser" search for CRE PAC and get shopping. There are a wide variety of labels you can create.

**Return it Depot-** Walk up with your bottle returns in a clear of see-through blue plastic bag and put in the school's phone number (604)-942-0241 into the express return machine- print out your labels and place them on the bags to leave the express return area for you deposit to go to the fundraising efforts. Don't forget to scan the bag! There is a maximum of 12 glass bottles per bag and 6 bags per day.
