And speaking of costumes (because the PAC costume sale is today and tomorrow)...

It may seem like a long way off, but Hallowe'en will soon be fast upon us. We're sure you've started hearing about it already, just like we are. This year, as you're thinking about costumes, a few important things to keep in mind:

- Please do not send students with inflatable costumes. These have become increasingly popular and present a host of challenges. Each year, students bring them and need a great deal of assistance getting in and out of them, costumes get ripped or torn, batteries die (remarkably quickly!) and there are lots of tears when the costume is essentially kaput by lunchtime. They're also quite cumbersome and make it difficult to navigate crowded classrooms. These costumes are great fun so let's save them for the Trick-or-treating in the evening!
- Also remember that school-based Hallowe'en is intended more fun than scary, especially with our littlest ones being here. Costumes must not depict gore, violence, or include weaponry. This can be disappointing for older costumers but again – save that for the evening festivities!



School start time reminders

Now that we are well into the groove of school, this is a friendly reminder that school begins at 8:52 each day. Occasionally, life happens, but for the most part that means we expect students to be here at 8:52 too.

A lot of our important learning happens at the start of the day, including literacy skills, reading, and others. Students who are regularly arriving late are missing out on important learning, and late arrivals are also disruptive to the learning of others, with teachers needing to interrupt their lessons to catch up students, help get settled, etc.

Please make every effort to have students here on time. Your cooperation is appreciated.

School Supplies fees now online

You will have received a notification in your <u>School Cash Online</u> account that a new item has been entered for school supplies. As you know, we purchase school supplies in bulk at Coquitlam River Elementary, saving you from the shopping, and ensuring we can get the correct supplies we need at the best value.

As soon as possible, please go to your <u>School Cash</u> <u>Online</u> account, to which you can find a link on the front page of the <u>school website</u>, and pay school supply fees so we are able to keep things running smoothly.



You will also find access to necessary <u>forms</u> to be filled out each year, including Emergency Release (if you have not already returned the one sent home), School Policies, medical alerts (if required) and optional forms for volunteering.

If you have any difficulty accessing your account, please contact the office for assistance.

Another reminder about personal electronics

As technology continues to proliferate, it is important to be aware of school and district policy around the use of electronic devices, including cellular phones, smart watches, and other communication devices.

All cellular phones, smart watches, or similar personal communication devices are to be appropriately stored during the school day, and are not permitted for use during the school day. This is in accordance with School District Policy 17, and Administrative Procedure 140.2

We recognize some students, particularly those traveling alone, may have been provided with communication devices for safety purposes on the way to and from school. Devices must be kept in backpacks once students arrive at school. If you need to get a message to your student, please contact the office and we will happily get a message to your student for you.





