Some changes to the school organization

As some of you are now aware, the school and school district had to make the very rare decision to change the school organization after the placement of students in classes. This was necessary due to district-wide, and province-wide challenges hiring a replacement teacher for one of our French Immersion classes. As a result, one division was collapsed and some French classes were reorganized in order to be able to preserve French Immersion instruction at École Coquitlam River Elementary. All adults to the office


Please note that all adults *must* check in at the office. As part of our security protocols, we ask that you do not go directly to classrooms. If your child is coming late, or you are picking up early, please come to the office and we will take the child to the class, or bring the child to the office for pick up. Similarly, if you are dropping off an item (backpacks, lunches, etc.) please bring it to the office and we will deliver the item to classrooms. This helps us to ensure we are aware of all adults in the building and we keep our school safe and secure.

Attendance Procedures Reminder

At the start of the year, it's worth a reminder about ensuring we are aware of your child's attendance for each day of school. Of course, we encourage students to be at school as much as possible, but if they are sick...like any of us, they should stay home. If students will be away, please use the <u>attendance report feature</u> accessible on the front page of the <u>school website</u>. Traffic safety reminders

Thank you to the many parents who are already following our traffic rules.

You may have noticed the presence of ICBC and RCMP community traffic safety staff on site yesterday, helping to make sure things are running smoothly and safely around the school.

As a reminder, the same rules apply to the traffic loop at *the rear* of the school as the front. That is, there is *no parking* of your vehicle in the loop, in front of the garbage bins, or in the designated daycare parking spots. *Do not leave your car*. If you are walking your child to the door or playground, you must park on Shaughnessy Street. The loop is for quick drop off only. Cars blocking up the traffic loop create backups on Shaughnessy, which makes travel difficult and potentially unsafe.

As much as possible, we encourage students and families who are able to walk or ride to school. It not only makes for better traffic flow, research tells us that students who walk to school – or part way to school when you have to park far away! – have improved metabolic and cardiovascular health, better academic performance and concentration, enhanced mental well-being and even better sleep. It's literally a win-win!

Following these simple protocols will allow for the safe, efficient movement of students and traffic as it enters and exits the property. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Seeking before and after school care

Student information verification forms

You likely received an email – or will shortly – from our MyEd system indicating that a new form available. On the front of the login page, you will see a *pdf* form with all of the contact information we currently have on file.

Please take a moment to carefully review the form. If there are any changes needed, please print out the form, make any changes, and send the revised form back to the school. If no changes are needed, you need take no further action. The report will appear on the front page when you login, under the 'Published Reports' heading.

As a refresher on the <u>MyEducation family portal</u>, please log in using the following format:

Use the email address we already have on file, from which you are receiving *this* email.

Growing bodies...growing appetites

As we move into our regular routines for the school year, it's important to monitor what is coming home in our student's lunch bags, and to periodically check in to see what's being eaten... and what isn't. A fed body makes for fed minds, and as our students grow, we sometimes need to adjust the amount of food being sent to school.

If your student is coming home from school *ravenous*, it might be a sign that a little bigger lunch or snack is needed. If a lot of food is coming home, it may be a sign

that they're struggling to eat what is sent. Planning with variety and balance ensures they have the fuel needed for learning and play without waste.

Prepping for the change in weather

We wouldn't know it from the sunny start to the new year we've had so far, but this is a little reminder that our students do go outside to play...rain or shine. That does mean that being prepared for some wet days is an important step. Please make sure students have appropriate clothing available for whatever mother nature may throw at us, including boots, rain jackets, etc. Having backup clothing for those unexpected puddle visits is also a good idea!
