Cultural	Changes Annually	Hanukkah Hanukkah is the Jewish eight-day, wintertime "festival of lights," celebrated with a nightly menorah lighting, special prayers and fried foods.
Cultural	Changes Annually	Birthday of Guru Nanak Dev Sahib A Sikh holiday that celebrates with a procession of songs and hymns.
Anti-racism	18-Dec	International Migrants Day A day to honor the contributions made by immigrants across the world.
Anti-racism	20-Dec	International Human Solidarity Day An initiative taken by the United Nations Assembly to raise a concern about world poverty. This day is celebrated to eradicate world problems like corruption, terrorism, hunger, and illiteracy and establish world peace and harmony.
Cultural	21-Dec	Winter Solstice (Northern Hemisphere) The shortest period of daylight and the longest night of the year. This date is celebrated by, and has significance to, multiple cultures and religions.
Indigenous	24-Dec to 07-Jan	Quviasukvik Inuit winter feast and festival observed by the Inuit, Yupik, Aleut, Chukchi, Iñupiat, and NunatuKavut. Celebrates the coming year and placates the roaming spirits for good luck in the year to come.
Cultural	25-Dec	Christmas Day A Christian holiday commemorating the birth of Jesus Christ, usually observed as a religious and cultural celebration.
Cultural	26-Dec to 01-Jan	Kwanzaa Kwanzaa is an African-American cultural holiday that has been adopted around the world including in Canada to celebrate African family, community and culture.
Cultural	Changes Annually	Bodhi Day A Buddhist holiday that commemorates the day that Gautama Buddha (Shakyamuni) is said to have experienced enlightenment, also known as bodhi in Sanskrit and Pali.
Cultural	All Month	Tamil Heritage Month A month to celebrate the rich heritage and contributions of Tamil people in Canada.
Indigenous	01-Jan	Ochetookeskaw - Kissing Day – Hand Shaking Day (Métis) A Métis day of celebration.
Cultural	01-Jan	New Year's Day A day to celebrate the first day of the year according to the Gregorian calendar.
Disabilities / Diverse Abilities	04-Jan	World Braille Day A day to celebrate Braille and what it means for the human rights of people who are blind or partially sighted.
Cultural	05-Jan	Birthday of Guru Gobind Singh A Sikh festival to celebrate the 10th Guru of the Sikhs.
