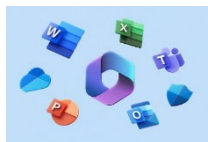


What's New on the Ridge

Student Home Use Microsoft 365: All School District 43 students may use Microsoft 365 apps at home, for free. Note – Microsoft 365 is the new name for Office 365. Home use includes installing desktop or mobile apps on multiple devices and using the in-browser (online) app versions. You will need your child's Microsoft account information.

Anti-racism	16-Nov	International Day for Tolerance A day to recognize that people are diverse and only tolerance can ensure the survival of mixed communities in every region of the globe.
Indigenous	16-Nov	Louis Riel Day Time to reflect on the life of Louis Riel, his important role for the advocacy of the Métis Nation and his help in building the Canada we know today.
2SLGBTQIA+	18-Nov	International day of LGBTQIA People in STEM A day to celebrate and highlight the work and barriers of LGBTQIA+ people in science, technology, engineering, and maths (STEM).
Health	20-Nov	World Children's Day World Children's Day was first established in 1954 as Universal Children's Day and is celebrated on 20 November each year to promote international togetherness, awareness among children worldwide, and improving children's welfare.
Health	20-Nov	National Child Day National Child Day is celebrated in Canada on November 20 in recognition of our country's commitment to upholding the rights of children and two historic events: the 1959 signing of the UN Declaration of the Rights of the Child and the adoption of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child in 1989.
2SLGBTQIA+	20-Nov	Transgender Day of Remembrance Transgender Day of Remembrance (TDOR) is an annual observance on November 20 that honors the memory of the transgender people whose lives were lost in acts of anti- transgender violence.

Cultural	24-Nov	Martyrdom of Guru Tegh Bahadur A Sikh day of observance for the death and impact of the ninth Sikh Guru.
Gender Equity	25-Nov to 10- Dec	16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence Every year, from November 25 to December 10, Canadians observe the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence. It is an opportunity to come together to call out, speak up and renew our commitment to end gender-based violence.
Anti-racism	4 th Sat of Nov	Holodomor Memorial Day A day to remember and honour the millions of victims of the Holodomor, the famine genocide deliberately inflicted on Ukrainian people in 1932 and 1933 by Joseph Stalin's totalitarian regime.
