Principal's Report – Don Hutchinson

- Lunch is a bit longer this year to allow more time for eating for the younger students
- West coast recess meaning kids will go out rain or shine. Parents please make sure that kids have an extra set of close and proper rain gear for the weather.
- Open House by Kal Tire in September was a success this was ran by donation to the PACamount to be announced

- Remembrance Day Assembly- any parents or grandparents of children who are in public service are welcome to attend in uniform.
- Grade 4/5: BYOD for this year has been put on hold due to additional technical requirements so for now we will use the existing school technology.
- New Report cards this year will be the same format but will be done through My Ed program as of next year will be paperless and accessible through the parent portal.
- Class meeting area is to lower traffic through the school as well as stop children from entering the class without an adult in attendance.
- Teacher collaborative schedule: students are with Mr. Hutchinson time spent doing either: Fundamental movement skills (FMS) or Walk away, ignore, tell, or seek help (WITS)
- Soar awards new format this year: primary grade will continue to receive awards and intermediate grade will be doing something different.
- Rocks have removed from the large steps by the portables. Currently dug up but will be replaced with something that is more solid/permanent.

Questions for the Principal:

Q: The extra courses (before and after school) can they be extended to include kindergarten students in the future?

A: Many of the courses are community run and ages are there decision. Boks has been run with K's in the past but the experience is the Kindergarten students are still getting used to school and are often too tired.

Q: Is there safety protocol for on site workers?

A: District employees do check in with the office. There was a roofer on site this year he was a contractor as soon as Don heard he was onsite he asked that he leave and come back after school hours. Don will bring up this up with the district.

All visitors are required to check in at office however they do not give necessarily give details of work.

Q School buses for field trips. Is there anyway to raise money for buses for student field trips? This would be more environmentally friendly.

A: Buses are expensive and for Grade 4 and up only two kids per seat. Within the next two years it will be too expensive to use for field trips.

- Parking and traffic is still an issue this year. We will need to discus this further at another meeting.
- Bylaw officers have been out to ticket parents.
- Have had HASTE BC and the city come out in the past to look at options.
