8. School Grounds and Facility Update:

- *i.* **New Fencing:** Safety fencing has been installed between the top of the two staircases
- *ii.* Emergency Backup Lighting: has been replaced throughout the facility
- *iii.* **Red/Blue Playground**: Existing wood chips removed, new drainage system installed, and new wood chips installed
- iv. Library Roof: Replacement was competed over the summer
- v. **Sensory Pathway:** New sensory pathway has been installed in the hallway to the gym. Previous pathway was removed as the hallway flooring was replaced
- vi. **Heating and Ventilation:** Since summer 2021 we have a new boiler system serving the building, including new air handling unit for the multi-purpose room.

Installation was completed over the summer. All other HAVC systems have been assessed and meet all safety specifications and requirements. We are using Merv 9A Dual filters.

10. Ministry Health and Safety Protocols Update:

Fortunately, from September to December we continued to exercise many of the health and safety protocols that were implemented last spring. As a result, we are well positioned to meet recently announced enhanced safety measures for schools. Some of the protocols that continue to be followed are:

- Mask wearing indoors for all grades, except while eating or drinking
- Handwashing/sanitizing upon entry and many times throughout the day
- Staggered entry/dismissal schedules
- Limited number of students in the washrooms
- Directional guidance and group separation in hallways
- School wide assemblies held virtually only
- The daily health check for all staff and students
- Students who become ill at school are removed from the classroom and parents are contacted for pick up
- Daily cleaning and disinfecting of desks, tables, devices and other high use/travelled areas
- Limited access for visitors

Some changes implemented since January 10th are:

- Physical distancing (2m) in the school and in classrooms where possible
- Mandatory wearing of masks for all students unless there is an underlying health condition. If your child does have an underlying health condition and needs to be exempt from wearing a mask please contact Mr. Hutchinson
- Zones for groups during outside breaks
- All meetings (Parent/Teacher) to be virtual
- Functional School Closures: A **functional closure** is when we cannot adequately supervise or instruct children. In this case, the situation could arise that due to staff illness, we have insufficient staff to provide safe supervision of children, or to provide instruction for an extended duration. If this happens, students will need to move to a period of learning from home. This period is intended to be 7 calendar days and materials and support for this time will be provided by the classroom teacher.
