

 - i. **Red/Blue Playground**: Existing wood chips will be removed, new drainage system installed, and new wood chips installed (Week of October 25th)

 - iii. **Sensory Pathway:** New sensory pathway has been installed in the hallway to the gym. Previous pathway was removed as the hallway flooring was replaced

All other HAVC systems have been assessed and meet all safety specifications and requirements. We are using Merv 9A Dual filters.
 - v. **Traffic System:** Please note the new traffic system (lanes and lights) at the Falcon/Guildford intersection
- Traffic Safety and Student Drop-Off/Pick-Up: We continue to have problems
 with our student drop-off and pick up each morning. Here are some examples of
 what I am witnessing:
 - Parents parking on the east side of Falcon (going up the hill) and leaving their car to supervise their child to their classroom. This area is a designated drop-off/pick up only. The driver of the vehicle must remain in the car at all times.
 - When parking your car in the designated parking areas (west side on Falcon going down the hill or north of the school) we ask you park as close to the curb as possible. Some cars are parked 1m or more from the curb which makes it difficult for passing cars, especially buses and larger vehicles.
 - Please do not park in front of the entrance way to our north west doors (turn around area) as this blocks the handicap parking area
 - Parents crossing the street with their children should be done using the crosswalks either north of the school near Peregrine or south near Guilford
 - U-Turns on Falcon in front of the school and near the Peregrine crosswalk
 - Staff Parking Lots are for staff only.
 - Thanks for your support as this is becoming a safety concern for our children. We have been in contact with the City Bylaws who informed us they will be increasing their presence here at the school
