1.	EPIC! 	Grades K-5 <p>EPIC! (https://www.getepic.com/) is used to support building literacy skills including fluency and comprehension. 2.	RAZ-Kids 	Grades K-5 <p>Raz-Kids and/or KIDS A-Z (https://www.raz-kids.com) support building literacy skills including fluency and comprehension. Raz-Kids is a website and Kids A-Z is for mobile devices is an online based reading program that allows students access to a virtual bookroom with interactive ebooks and reading quizzes through internet-enabled devices. 3.	Sumdog 	Grades 2-5 <p>Sumdog (http://www.sumdog.com) is an online leveled math skills practice site, in a game format, with many different games to choose from. Different games are unlocked as students complete more math questions. Students see only their own progress level. Students can play against classmates or other players, but there is no communication with other players. 4.	Matific 	Grades 1-5 Matific (https://www.matific.ca/ca/en-ca/home/) is an online adaptive math skills practice site, in a game format, with many different games to choose from. From Common Sense Media (see review below): “Matific is a collection of interactive math games and activities (on the website, tablet, or Chrome app) for grades K-6 aimed at helping kids build a conceptual understanding of various foundational skills.” There is no communication with other players. 5.	Scratch 	Grades 3-5 Scratch (http://scratch.mit.edu) is a block-based programming tool allowing young learners to create interactive games, stories, and animations. Students will also share their creations with others in the online community from school and home as part of classroom assignments. Students will be freely sharing code, art, music, and other works.
