- School just finished Maple Creek articulation for Grade 5 moving to Grade 6.
 - Grades 4 and 5 had a Public Speaking Presentation for the whole school.

 - Glen Elementary has less enrollments compared to last year (around 500). The school is predicted to have 23 divisions in 2025-2026, one less than 2024-2025.
 - Next year kindergarten-Grade 1 will be blended together and the school is seeing the initiative as very beneficial.
