As a parent myself, I realize lots of information comes at you from schools, but I try and keep things short and to the point, so the reading of the information is not burdensome. Happy reading!

The Week That Was

We had an energetic and enthusiastic beginning to the 2023.24 school year. As usual, it was fantastic to see all of the children fill the playgrounds and classrooms this week. During our initial staff meeting on Tuesday, September 5th, we spoke about the power of connection. Staff were asked to observe a picture of two children on summer

vacation and write one word they thought each child was feeling on Day 1 of school. With that same lens of empathy, each staff member wrote down one word to describe how they were feeling on Day 1 of school. We ended the Welcome Back Staff Meeting with watching this <u>Brené Brown video</u>, comparing the notion of empathy and sympathy. During our Staff Meeting on Monday, September 11th, we will unpack some of these words with the intention of walking in another's shoes.

Looking Forward

On Monday, September 11th students entering Grades 1 – 5 will meet their 2023.24 classroom teacher. As I outlined in my email yesterday, parents will receive an email on Friday evening or early Saturday morning identifying their child's teacher. Upon receiving this email, please check Table 1 of the start-up document (that was sent to parents last week) for pick-up and drop-off location information based on your child's assigned teacher. With students assigned to classes, please be mindful of the work that your children's teachers put into placing students. Each year, an entire day in May is dedicated to the placement process that considers the academic and social needs of your children, as well as the review I do during the summer of all class placements.
