The Months of January and February.

Here is some information about <u>Early French Immersion registration</u> and the process for <u>cross catchment</u> applications as we get closer to the month of January.

The first message is specific to current Grade K-4 families who have a child in the Early French Immersion Program at École Glenayre Elementary and who have an incoming Kindergarten child (for the 2024.25 school year) that is a sibling of a current French Immersion child. There is nothing to do right now; however, I wanted to remind these families that they **must apply** for the Early French Immersion Program of Choice if they wish for their incoming Kindergarten child to get into the same program. More information about French Programs of Choice can be found <u>here</u>. **Programs of choice registration happens from January 11-17, 2024.**

The second message concerns the cross-catchment process. I hyperlinked this information in the initial section of the Principally Speaking piece. Families withing to attend Glenayre Elementary but who are not in catchment, have a process for being able to potentially join the Glenayre community.

The third message is for *current Grade 5 families* interested in *Late French Immersion*. Children with siblings in a Program of Choice must still apply online and fill in sibling information. Failure to do so will result in the incoming sibling not getting into the program. More details regarding the Late French Immersion program are found <u>here</u>.
