While being respectful of the gravity of the residential school story that plays an influential role in the National Truth and Reconciliation Day, Orange Shirt Day encourages all children to have a sense of belonging. For elementary-aged students, this sense of belonging takes many forms but the journey toward a shared understanding of Indigenous ways of living begins with walking a path different than ours, potentially.

Last year, we attempted to have some common messaging and activities to help students understand and reflect on the slogan of Orange Shirt Day which is *Every Child Matters*, as well as the National Truth and Reconciliation Day. This year, teachers have a larger list of activities that reflect a broader view of the First Peoples Principles of Learning (FPPL) in hopes that there is an entry point for all classes to participate in one of them.
