Every Child Matters t-shirt cutout had older students identify why it's important to every child that they are seen to matter and for those younger students, they spoke about being kind as a point of emphasis.

I connect this activity to the words of George Couros when it comes to learning because many of them are also a reflection of the First Peoples Principles of Learning (FPPL); in particular that learning ultimately supports the well-being of the self, the family, and the community. And for students, this means being able to walk in the footsteps of others so as to understand what well-being means to others.



My hope is that each day, the inquisitive minds of our Glenayre students afford them an opportunity to think about why every child matters. Maybe not today because they are not cognitively ready. Maybe not tomorrow, either. But the next day because we have allowed them to explore what is around them and ask probing questions that have open-ended responses.
