This summer, families at our school can save on summer camps while also supporting our PAC!

Use the code PAC10 when registering for any eligible camp week and receive \$10 off your child's registration. For every use of the code, our PAC will also receive a \$10 donation at the end of the summer.

For example, if 100 camp weeks are booked using the code, families would save a total of \$1,000 and our PAC would receive a \$1,000 donation. Donations will be sent to the school PAC by e-transfer in September.

The code can be used multiple times for:

- Multiple camp weeks
 - Multiple siblings
- Eligible camps include:
- Seaview Community School Camp
 - Reel Adventures: Tri-Cities Camp
 - Youth Only: Tri-Cities Camp
 - Kids Only: Port Moody Camp
- The discount applies to full camp weeks, including:
- 5-day weeks (Monday–Friday)

- 4-day weeks (June 29–July 3 and August 4–7)

To use the code:

1. Register online
2. Enter the code PAC10 in the discount section
3. Include your child’s school name on the registration form

These non-profit camps focus on outdoor play, nature exploration, kindness, creativity, and building friendships. Camp activities may include trips to beaches, parks, playgrounds, pools, and other fun local spots.

A new Kids Only: Port Moody Camp is available this summer for children in Kindergarten to Grade 2. Planned outings may include White Pine Beach, Rocky Point Spray Park, Old Orchard Park Beach, and other local parks and playgrounds. Indoor activities are planned for days with heavy rain or wildfire smoke.

Camp locations change daily depending on the outing, and families will meet and pick up near the outing location each day.
