

When does the school day start for a typical Grade 9 student?

If we had not been required to alter our schedule this year for the pandemic, the planned schedule was for block 1 to start at 9:05 and block 4 to end at 3:20 pm. It is not yet determined if next year's start time will be exactly the same.

What number of students went on to university last year?

We do not keep statistics on this, as post-secondary institutions communicate offers of admission to students directly for privacy reasons.

My child is getting help with Math and Language Arts currently. What options are there for a student with learning disabilities to have modified courses to help them succeed in High School? Also, how is it determined if a student should register for the Learning Centre instead of taking a third elective?

If your child has an IEP, the Student Services Case Manager will be involved in creating their schedule and will work with your child's teachers to deliver the curriculum in a way that fits the IEP goals. Your child's Middle School Case Manager will consult with you when you are filling out the Course Selection Form if a Learning Centre block is recommended and will then share this information with us during the Articulation Meetings.

My kid has a case manager in the middle school to offer additional supports on both her academic and social skills. Will she get the similar supports in secondary school? Whether she will get supports on how to choose her career path in the future if she is not able to take post secondary education?

Yes. If your child has an IEP, they will have a Case Manager who will connect with the school-based support team (teachers, counsellors, Youth Workers, our Post-Secondary and Career Advisor, and specialized resources as appropriate).
