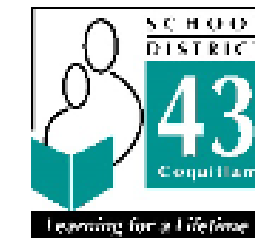

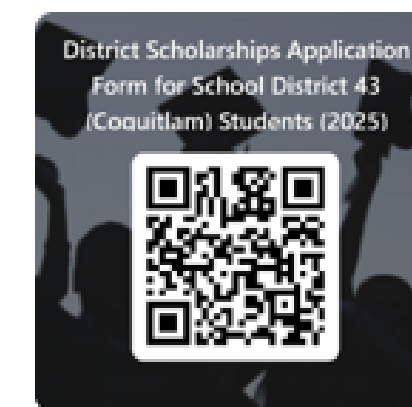



1. **Personal Letter** (approximately 300 words): Describe how receiving a scholarship will assist you in achieving your post-secondary goals, any adversity you've overcome, your proudest achievements, or any special circumstances the committee should be aware of (e.g., financial need, unique learning needs, service to others).
2. **Resume or Brag Sheet:** Prepare to upload your personal letter and resume/prag sheet with your application.
