Women in Trades Training (WITT)



The School of Construction and the Environment at BCIT will be piloting a new program to promote women in the Electrical trade this summer for **current grade 11 female** students (who will be in grade 12 come July 1) who are interested in doing the "Electrical Foundations" program at their Burnaby campus in early August 2021.
