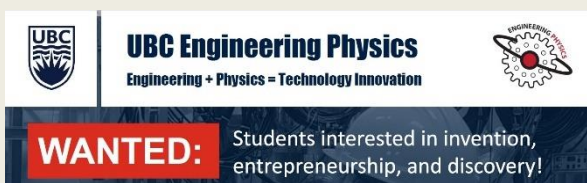
BCIT - Big Info: At-home Edition - Join us online February 22-25, 2021 from 4-8pm
