At the end of the summit, the culminating project is a polished memo to persuade policymakers to address an issue relevant to their communities that works to fulfill one of the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

You are invited to join the International **Microsoft DigiGirlz Program** designed to provide girls, aged 14-18, with a better understanding of what a career in technology is like, offer hands on experience in workshops and hackathons, and enable cross cultural collaboration and networking.

This year, the **DigiGirlz Bootcamp starts on March 8**, coinciding with *International Women's Day*. It will consist of **90-minute bootcamps** throughout the week. During the sessions, attendees will get hands on

experience on how technology can support the UN's Sustainability Development Goals (SDG's). The Bootcamp will be closed with a hackathon where girls will get to demonstrate their creativity and international collaboration on a solution aligning to one of the 17 SDG's.

This year the bootcamp is 100% virtual and will be using the opportunity to connect with girls across North America and Africa.
