SOYL Summer Program 2021



Fresh Roots will be running the **Sustainable Opportunities for Youth Leaders (SOYL) Summer Program** again this year at all three locations (Vancouver, Delta, and Coquitlam).

SOYL is a 6-week program where youth work on a schoolyard farm to learn how to grow and harvest veggies alongside with mentors and farmers.

Participants will attend workshops designed to build leadership skills, transferable job skills, and food system literacy. There are a couple of options for

receiving credit for your participation in the SOYL program. You will also receive \$600 stipend for attending the 6 weeks program.
