SPIRIT WEEK



On Saturday, April 12, secondary school students across the district will be hosting a district-wide Clothing Swap meet at Pinetree Secondary School. This event aims to combat fast fashion by offering a space to recycle quality clothing and find something new-to-you!

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?
All SD43 families, from elementary to secondary school, are welcome to join. Those that donate will be given priority access, though everyone will be able to participate.

DONATION COLLECTION
Spring Break is the perfect time to clean out your closet. Secondary schools will be collecting donations from April 2 – April 10.

WHAT TO BRING

- Gently used clothing in good condition (clean, no stains, rips, or excessive wear).
- Clothing for all ages and sizes, including men's, women's, and children's items.
- Also accepting, shoes, jewelry and accessories.

SWAP DAY GUIDELINES

- **Donate and Earn Credits:** Receive 10 credits for a large bag (Regular garbage bag) or 5 credits for a small bag of clothing. Each credit equals one item you can pick up from the swap. Those who donate will receive credits and gain VIP access from 9 AM – 12 PM to exchange credits for clothing. After 12 PM, all SD43 families are invited to take anything for free with no limits to what you can take.

Credits will be distributed by the collection teams at your local Secondary schools at time of delivery.
