#### **SWAP DAY GUIDELINES**

Donate and Earn Credits: Receive 10 credits for a large bag (Regular garbage bag) or 5 credits for a small bag of clothing. Each credit equals one item you can pick up from the swap. Those who donate will receive credits and gain VIP access from 9 AM – 12 PM to exchange credits for clothing. After 12 PM, all SD43 families are invited to take anything for free with no limits to what you can take.

Credits will be distributed by the collection teams at your local Secondary schools at time of delivery
