SWAP DAY GUIDELINES

Donate and Earn Credits: Receive 10 credits for a large bag (Regular garbage bag) or 5 credits for a small bag of clothing. Each credit equals one item you can pick up from the swap. Those who donate will receive credits and gain VIP access from 9 AM - 12 PM to exchange credits for clothing. After 12 PM, all SD43 families are invited to take anything for free with no limits to what you can take
