The Pathway to Teacher Education scholarship is awarded to 20 outstanding high school graduates who have demonstrated a commitment to and aptitude for a career in K–12 teaching. To qualify, the program must lead to eligibility to **apply for a B.C. teaching certificate** and teach in the K–12 school system in this province.

Eligibility:

- Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident, be a BC resident.
- Minimum 'B' in grades 11 and 12 courses required for graduation.
