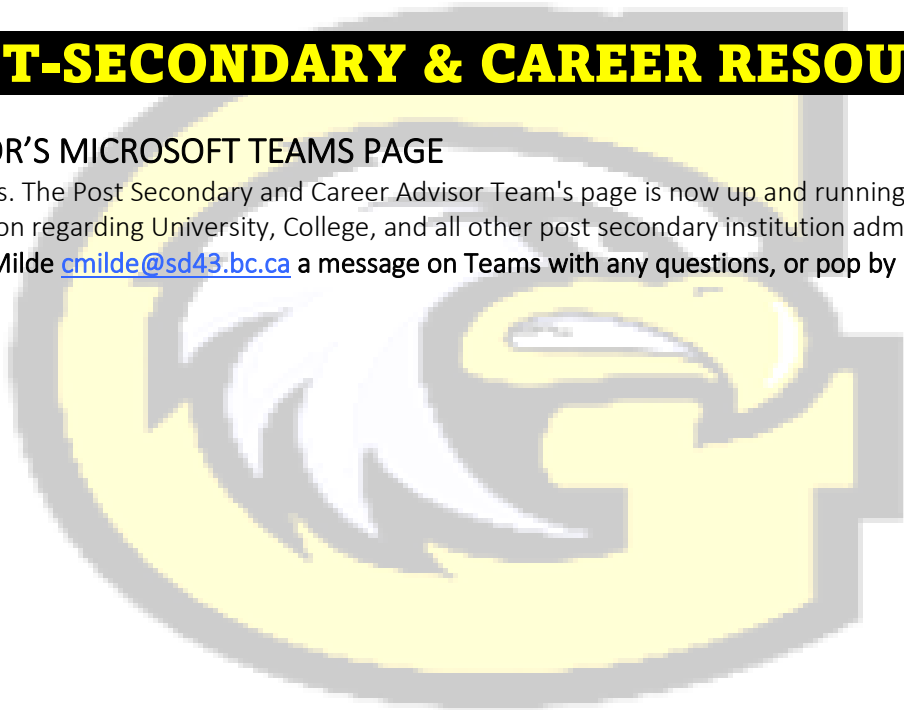
BAKE SALE
