SUMMER SCHOOL LOTTERY

A reminder to please let us know immediately about summer school plans as this has a direct impact on your course requests for next year. 1. If you had previously told us of intentions to take a summer school course, we now need to know if you are registered in that course or did not get a spot.
2. If you had not previously indicated summer school plans, and now you are registered in a course that you had originally put in your course requests, we need to make adjustments!

Students who received a summer school spot through the lottery should have been notified by now. **If it is a course that has a material fee, you need to finalize your registration and pay that fee by Monday evening (tonight!).**

If you did not get a spot through the lottery, you can check the summer school website this Friday, May 15th when it re-opens, to see if space has become available in the course you want. **Remember to update your counsellor about any and all changes please!**

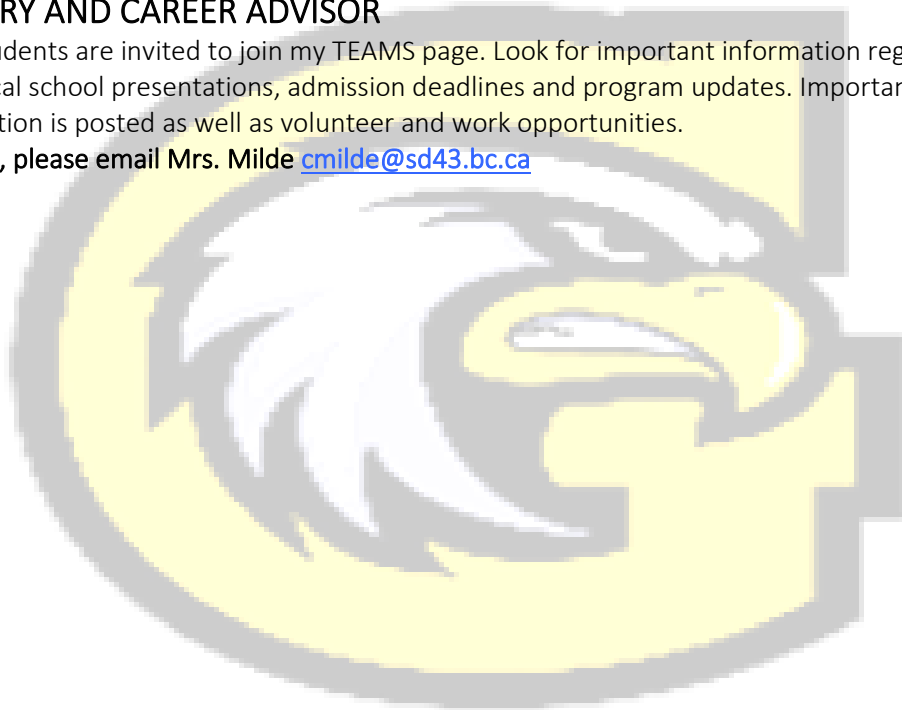

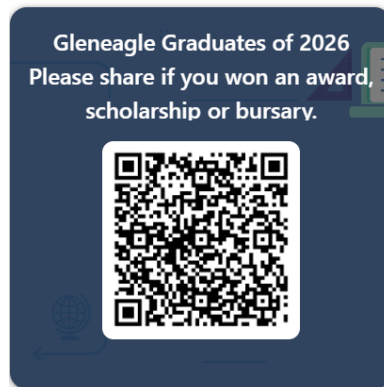
