SR. SAIL TICKETS

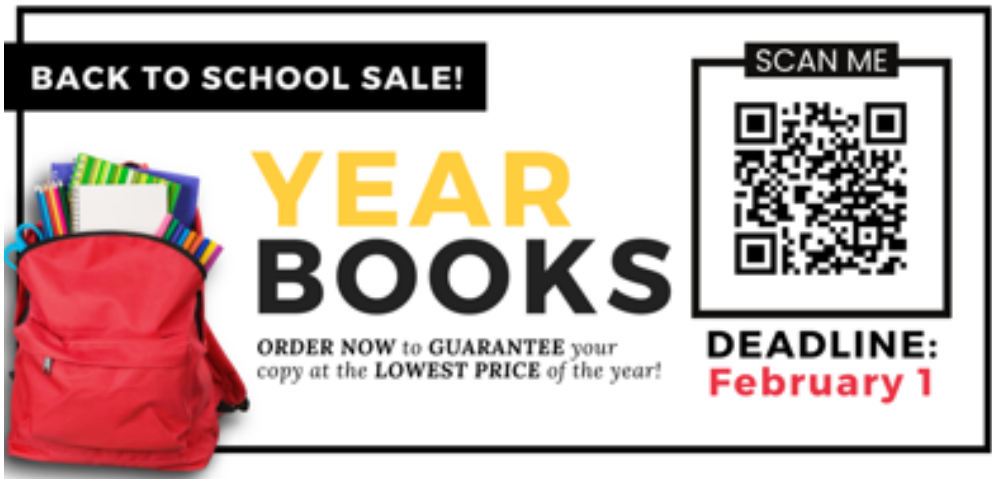
