**PRO-D DAY THIS FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 19<sup>TH</sup>**

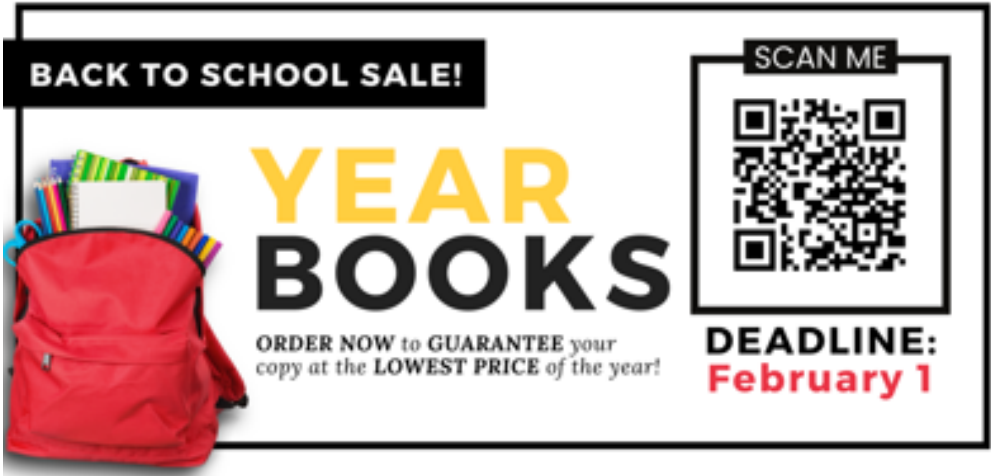
Please note this Friday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, is a Pro-D Day. School will not be in session for students.
