This is a unique chance to make unforgettable memories, practice French in real-life settings, and experience Canadian history and culture.

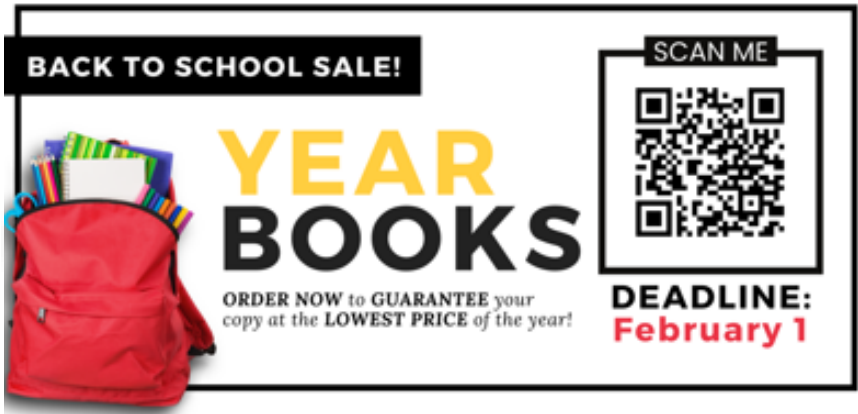
