

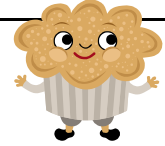

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

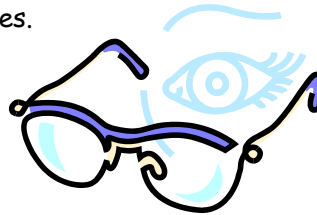
