The Professional Development Program at Simon Fraser University is excited to offer four days of hands-on, action-packed activities this **Spring Break** from **Tuesday, March 17th through Friday, March 20th, 2015** for students from grades K-5. The four days of activities will run from **9:00 a.m. - 2:45 p.m.** each day.

This unique opportunity is part of a wonderful community partnership between Simon Fraser University and School District 43. During the four days of our "School of Wonderstanding," students will participate in a number of different activities such as cooking, crafts, indoor/outdoor games, dance, sports, science experiments, drama and of course, **FUN**. All sessions are fully supervised by Student Teachers in the Professional Development Program, as part of their teacher training. And they will be working under the supervision of certified teachers. Each session is designed to excite and delight participants with hands-on, creative learning opportunities to strengthen the connection of "wonder" and "understanding" of the world around us.

The "School of Wonderstanding" will be offered in 4 District Schools. **Seaview Community School** will be offering "School of Wonderstanding" activities with some **Aboriginal** cultural content. **James Park Elementary School** will be offering a French language experience within the "School of Wonderstanding" activities.

The cost for all 4 days of activities is **\$60 per student**, which includes supplies and materials. Participants will need to bring snacks, a bag lunch, a water bottle (with their name on it), dress comfortably and come ready to have **FUN**.
