Bus Guidelines

Please follow the guidelines below regarding bus pick up and drop off.

- No driving down past the gate (even on rainy days). Parents must park their car in the gravel lots and walk their children down. We are also encouraging families to walk or bike when possible.
- Buses are set to leave at 8:45 am. If you arrive late and the buses are driving away, please do not attempt to stop the bus as this is a safety hazard. Once the buses have departed parents are responsible for getting their child to school.
- Please refrain from walking around the buses and entering the buses.
- On rainy days the buses will allow students to enter and take their seats after 8:30 am. However, students need to be mindful of bus expectations while sitting on the bus and waiting for them to leave.

• Do not walk between the buses as they are entering or leaving the bus drop off area at pick-up. Use park pathways to walk to your vehicles or home.

How Return-It Express works:

- 1. At home, put your empty beverage containers into a clear or transparent plastic bags that are up to 90 liters in capacity, no sorting needed!
- Option 1 Dropping off your own bottles
 Contact our Grade 5 committee at <u>shawnamwc@hotmail.com</u> if you'd like
 printed labels OR <u>Visit a Return-It location</u>, type in <u>778-232-5564</u> and print
 your own labels. Add one Label to each clear bag.
 Return-It Express Address 2577 Kingsway Ave Port Coquitlam.
- Option 2 Want us to grab your bottles? Contact the Grade 5 Committee at <u>shawnamwc@hotmail.com</u> to arrange drop off/pick up of your bottles and containers.
- 4. At the Return-It Location, scan your bag labels with a scan gun located below the drop-off window. The screen on the kiosk will confirm if you successfully scanned your bag label and "Hazel Trembath Grade 5 Fundraising" will appear on the screen.
- 5. Return-It will sort your beverage containers and credit the Grade 5 Fundraiser account within 10 business days.

Inclement Weather
