Port Coquitlam Lacrosse Program- January 20th-24th

Kindergarten Registration

If you know of any families who wish to register their children for kindergarten next year, please let them know registration information is available on the Coquitlam School District Website. Kindergarten registration will take place from February 2nd to 4th.

Cross-Catchment Applications

Parents sometimes wish for their children to attend a school that is not their catchment school. In such cases, parents must first register at their catchment school, then apply for cross catchment. Information for parents who wish to apply for cross-catchment can be found on the Coquitlam School District website. The cross-catchment application process opens on February 7th and closes on February 12th. There is a process for kindergarten students, and one for students in Grades 1-12. Forms will be available online on February 7th.

Gymnastics Unit

Hazel Trembath will have the district's elementary gymnastics equipment set up in our gym from February 3rd to 21st. This will be an interesting and engaging addition to our Physical Education Curriculum.

Seymour Field Trip

We are planning a school-wide field trip for February 25th and 27th at Mt. Seymour for tubing and tobogganing. Additional information and details will be provided by your child's teacher, and appropriate forms will be made available online. We will divide the school in half and the trips will be on 2 separate days, February 25th for Divisions 5,6,7,8,9 and February 27th for Divisions 1,2,3,4.

Student Learning Surveys and MDI

Over the next few weeks our grade 4 students will be completing the annual Student Learning Survey. This survey is developed by the British Columbia Ministry of Education. Our school district is also participating in the Middle Years Development Instrument (MDI) project in January /February in partnership with the Human Early Learning Partnership (HELP) at UBC. **The MDI is for students in Grade(s) 4 & 8 and** is to understand more about children's thoughts, feelings and experiences inside and outside of school. The MDI questions align with the BC Ministry of Education's K-12 curriculum which includes a focus on promoting children's personal and social competencies.

Pink Shirt Day- February 26th

We encourage students to wear pink shirts on February 28th. On Pink Shirt Day we affirm our commitment to stand against bullying and to accept and respect all people, and to take time to understand different points of view and share experiences. By lifting each other up and wearing pink today, we are standing in solidarity against bullying and letting kids know they aren't alone.

Extreme Weather Conditions and Buses
