RISING UP TOGETHER

Resolving student or parent concerns

Situations such as grading practices, student discipline or exclusion from school activities may arise that can cause concerns for parents and students alike. In these instances, it's important to understand and act within the guidelines set forth by the school district. School District 43 has the following procedures in place for parents to follow when questioning decisions or actions taken by teachers or administrators.

Teacher or classroom level:

- 1. Discuss the matter directly with the teacher whose judgment or decision is being questioned.
- 2. If not resolved, discuss your concern with the Principal.
- 3. If not satisfied with the outcome, discuss your concern with the Assistant Superintendent, or designate.
- 4. Unresolved matters may be referred to the Board as per Board Policy 13 "Appeals Regarding Student Matters".

Principal or School level:

- 1. Discuss directly with the Principal the action, policy, procedure or practice being questioned.
- 2. If not resolved, refer to the Assistant Superintendent, or designate.
- 3. If not resolved, refer to the Board as per Board Policy 13.

It is expected that District personnel will seek a resolution to the problem as quickly as possible.

PAC versus DPAC - what's the difference?

Did you know that there's not only a PAC, but there's a DPAC? The District Parents' Advisory Councils (DPACs) are the legislated parent voice at the school district level, representing the collective views of school Parents' Advisory Councils (**PAC**) in a school district. Each PAC in the district must have a DPAC Representative, and Hazel's representatives are Rachel Sebestyn and Alaina Milicevic. DPACs advise the board of education on any matter relating to education in their school district.

The PAC is the officially recognized collective voice of parents of their school. A PAC, through its elected officers, may advise the school board, the principal and staff of the school respecting any matter relating to the education of the students and the school.
