Meeting Minutes

- 1) Call to Order at 7:01 pm by Alaina
- 2) Agenda and Approval of Previous Minutes- no comments and no additions. Motion approved by Megan and Anand. Motion Passes.

3) Chair's Report

- a) Successful First Day with Coffee and Timbits, lots of questions and engagement with the parent community
- b) Tons of work going on in the background for the upcoming BBQ this Thursday for Meet-the-Teacher
- c) Big thanks to Jason for all the communication to start the school year.
- d) On behalf of the PAC, Anand has reached out to our MLA, Mike Farnsworth, requesting a meeting around the next steps of the rebuild. Justin, his assistant, called and gave the lip service, with the possibility of a meeting early October, hopefully before the 2nd year anniversary of the fire. There continues to be a multi-prong effort to get a timeline for the rebuild of the school.

4) Principal's Report

- a) Each Principals report will include:
 - i.) What has happened
 - ii.) What is upcoming in the school community
 - iii.) Financial supports that are being requested.
- b) Christmas concert will be on Dec. 9 and 10th with help from Place des Arts as they provide the school with a music program. A big thanks to Ms. Panwar who was instrumental in setting this up. This school-wide activity is paid for by the Foundation.
- c) \$72,000 is still in the Foundation account and Jason will continue to request funds for school wide events.
- d) Staff Request \$1273.16 for the PAC to pay for planners (this was pushed for a vote in our October meeting)
- e) Gr.5's have set aside June 17 for the Leaving Ceremony. Teachers have confirmed they would like to continue the tradition of the field trip to Playland, but Playland cannot be booked until January. Additionally, a 4/5 Field Trip to Activate is in the works.



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- f) PAC Request to pay for the Bus to Playland
- g) Is there a PAC rep for Fresh Fruit and Veg Program? not at this time
- h) Clarification of \$600 for each Division for field trips. Historically, this comes from the gaming account.
- i) \$250 per class for Class Funds. These receipts will be collected at the end of the year.
- j) Smooth Start up with new staff, Mr. C (CCW) will be at the buses at drop off and pick up. 3 EAs are voluntarily riding buses! They will be alternating between buses.
- k) Gr. 4/5 Intermural Soccer has begun
- l) School wide assemblies each month to recognize students and share important information
- m) Bus BUDDY System this information was taught at an assembly and shared with families to review, as well as being reviewed regularly at school.
- n) Upcoming: Meet the Teacher Night on Sept. 18 Causal/BBQ, meet and greet and a casual way to meet the teachers. A great opportunity to take advantage of connecting with the school community.
- o) Pro D Day Staff will spend part of the day learning more about PDA (pathological demand avoidance).
- p) Truth and Reconciliation Day- September 30th school wide activities are being ironed out to bring attention to this day.
- q) Oct. 8th Terry Fox Run return bus early for a run at the old site. Families are invited to join!

6) Committee/Fundraising Volunteers & Events

- a) Welcome BBQ
 - i) All items have been purchased
 - ii) Confirmed with 250 buns to be picked up (not 250 dozen)
 - iii) BBQ is unpackaged and assembled, thank you!
 - iv) PAC and parent volunteers are ready!
 - v) Tables will be set up in the gym, and 3 tables on the wall for set-up. Garbage /recycling bins will be relocated.
 - vi) 5:00-6:00 BBQ time and then families are encouraged to visit classrooms
 - vii) BBQ is by donations (%50 of items have been donated) and no pressure to pay
 - viii) Conversation about a no-judgement box Megan and Winry to make one!



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- b) New fundraising suggestions for discussion

- 8) District PAC Representative Report First Meeting DPAC 101 is early October. Jeremy Clark Directions 2030 sharing the 5 year plan, this is open to all parents of SD43.
- 9) Vote to Approve 2025/2026 PAC Budget We are fundraising what we are spending.
 - Important conversations around Gaming Accounting Purchases Jason is going to attempt to have Skating and Drumming Approved by for the Foundation later in the year.
 - Much of our costs have been covered by the Foundations, but that money is dwindling.
 - We are attempting to not pass on all the costs to parents finding the balance
 - Is there a way to go on a school-wide field trip?
 - No concerns about the General Budget
 - Contentions around the Gaming Account, questions and wonders about removing Bus
 Transportation from our budget in order to pay for other events.



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- Many factors at play: like what items can come from Foundation money, is the school supporting Saleema Noon coming this year?
- Megan proposes to approve the General and Fundraising Budgets to keep it separate from Gaming discussions. Dave firsts, Alaina seconded. Unanimous.
- Megan called for a vote on the proposed Gaming Budget vs. Alternate Gaming Budget. Vote
 7-1 in favour of original Gaming Budget where field trips are funded instead of wish list items.
- We have passed the Gaming Account. Budget
- Amendment Planner motion to push the planner vote until October Meeting. We will wait to hear from staff feedback on Saleema Noon, as we could not fund both.
- Budgets are passed with Option 1 for Gaming Account
