# Hazel Trembath PAC's Annual General Meeting

The Hazel Trembath Parent Advisory Council Annual General Meeting (HT PAC AGM) is coming up on **Tuesday, May 20 at 7pm** in the Citadel Middle School Library. Please join us as we elect a new PAC executive. All positions are open.

Schools with a full PAC executive qualify for the BC Gaming Grant. This is \$20.00 per student, based on the previous year's enrolment. This would mean a Gaming Grant of approximately \$3,780.00 for next year. Gaming

Grant funds are used towards school wide learning enhancements. This year, the funds went to school busses for field trips. One bus to Mt. Seymour costs almost \$700.00!


