Hazel Trembath School Design Open House

SD43 is excited to announce that they will be hosting a community open house later this spring to share the current schematic design for the new Hazel Trembath Elementary School, including preliminary architectural drawings and renderings. The event will include a brief presentation, opportunities to view design display boards, ask clarifying questions, and provide written feedback on overall impressions. The project is approximately 50% through the design process, with the overall design direction now well established. This open house is intended to inform the community about the project and outline the next steps as it moves toward construction.

Once a date is confirmed, details about the Hazel Trembath Elementary Community Open House will be posted on the District website, shared through SD43 social media and will be communicated directly to the school community via the school newsletter and school website.
