Bus Expectations

Families, thank you for continuing to help our community by reinforcing bus expectations with your children at home. A few bus reminders to families as we complete the month of April and look towards the final two months of the school year:

Riding the bus is a privilege, not a right. Students must follow all rules to maintain this privilege. Students must behave respectfully toward the driver, other students, and property. Unsafe behavior may result in disciplinary action or loss of bus privileges.

Students must be at Settlers Park **at least 5 minutes before** the scheduled departure time – 8:40 am and families must be at Settlers Park **on time** to meet students, especially younger children. (buses arrive for 3:00 pm).

Without this grant, costs will be passed along to parents.
