Move. Create. Connect.

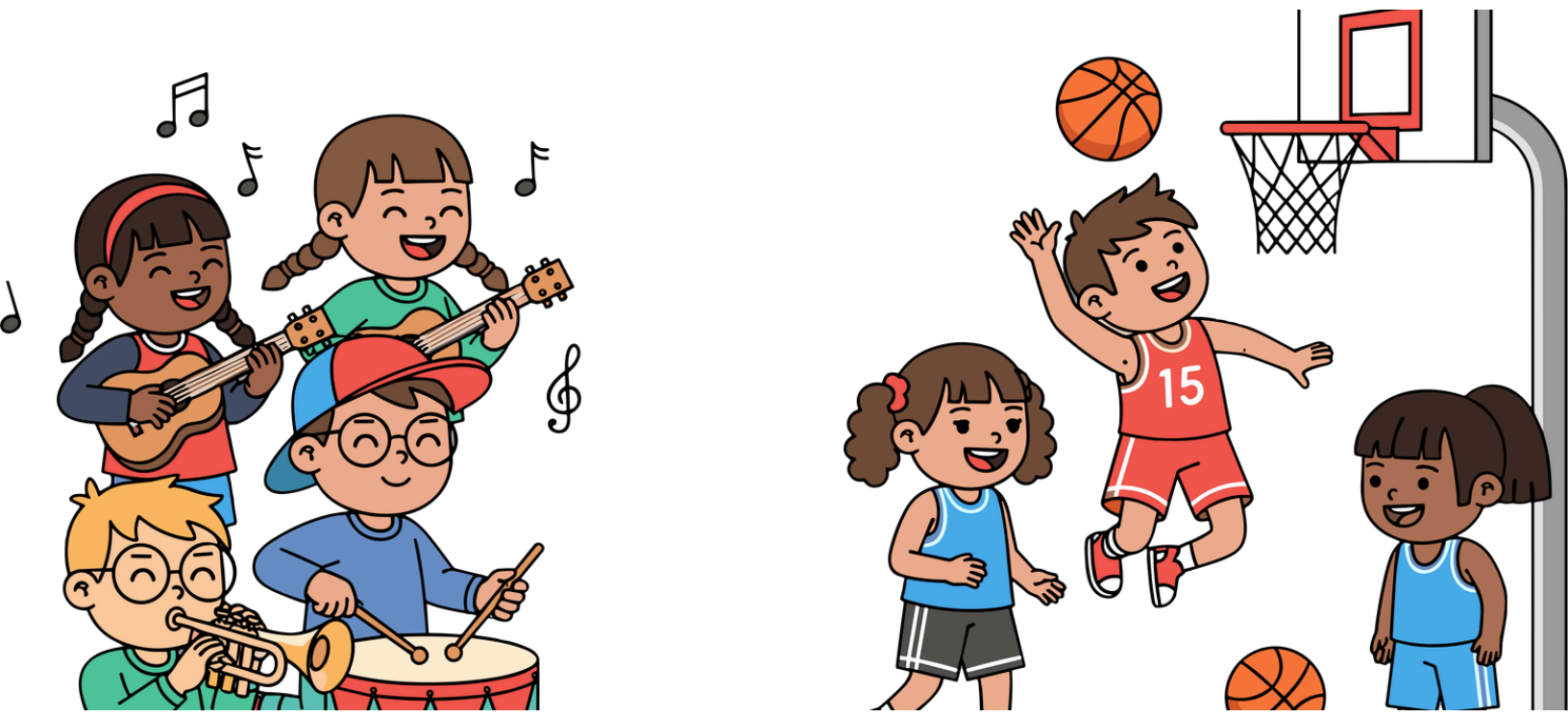
