Orange Shirt Day – Monday September 29

Families, as we look towards the Truth & Reconciliation Day National Holiday on September 30th, we wanted to share our intention as a school community to recognize this important day. We will be having an assembly on Monday morning to talk about the significance of the day and to explain to students the meaning behind Orange Shirt Day and wearing an Orange Shirt.

Following this short assembly, we will be taking time as a school to colour feathers and to put a word on them that expresses how we want to feel at school (safe, included, loved, accepted, etc.) Once they are all finished, we will collect the feathers to put on bulletin boards in our school. We are encouraging students to wear orange to school on September 29th.

Busing Update

Families, thank you for continuing to help our community by reinforcing bus expectations with your children at home. A few bus reminders to families as we complete our first month of the school year and look towards October:

Riding the bus is a privilege, not a right. Students must follow all rules to maintain this privilege. Students must behave respectfully toward the driver, other students, and property. Unsafe behavior may result in disciplinary action or loss of bus privileges.

Students must be at Settler's Park **at least 5 minutes before** the scheduled departure time – 8:45 am and families must be at Settler's Park **on time** to meet students, especially younger children. (buses arrive for 3:00 pm)
