In the next few days your child will be bringing home the Created By Kids Fundraiser form with their artwork on it. If you're not familiar with this fundraiser, this is where your child's artwork can get crafted into mugs, ornaments, Christmas cards, bags, puzzles, etc! It makes great gifts for the holidays.

The process:

- Teachers send home completed artwork on or before Oct. 27th
- Parents order & send artwork back to school before Nov. 4th
- Orders get picked up by Created By Kids from the School Nov. 7th
- Products delivered to the school for distribution the week of Nov. 24-28th

The sooner that orders are made (and artwork returned to the school) the better.

Please do not fold or bend the artwork and make sure it is sent back to the school after ordering. Your artwork must include your code/order number on your card when returned
