Bus Expectations Reminders

Families, thank you for continuing to help our community by reinforcing bus expectations with your children at home. A few bus reminders to families as we complete our second month of the school year and look towards November:

Riding the bus is a privilege, not a right. Students must follow all rules to maintain this privilege. Students must behave respectfully toward the driver, other students, and property. Unsafe behavior may result in disciplinary action or loss of bus privileges.

Students must be at Settler's Park **at least 5 minutes before** the scheduled departure time – 8:45 am and families must be at Settler's Park **on time** to meet students, especially younger children. (buses arrive for 3:00 pm)

On Tuesday, November 4th our school will be hosting a few Education Students from Simon Fraser University. They will be visiting our school for the day and observing teachers in a handful of classrooms.
