Families are invited to attend either of the two concerts and each concert is approximately one hour in duration.

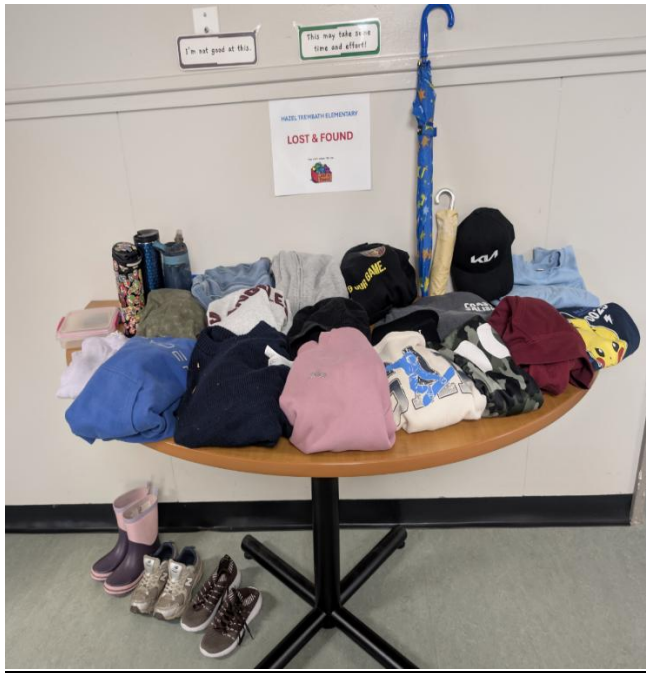
### **Construction Updates**
