Construction Update

The project continues to move forward, and the district—working closely with the architectural team—has made significant progress in terms of educational design as well as structural and geotechnical details. Geotechnical teams have been surveying the site the past week and the project remains on track and the district is pleased with how the work is unfolding. We are also proud of the strong collaboration between the district and the City of Port Coquitlam, which has helped ensure an efficient and well-coordinated process. The final footprint of the new school will be different from the original building and the new school will be two floors. Additional updates will be provided to families over the coming weeks. The team is working non-stop to bring this build to the community as quickly as possible and at this point construction is still slated to begin in July.
