Hazel Trembath School Design Update

Thank you to everyone who attended the Hazel Trembath Community Open House on Thursday, April 30. We were very pleased to see such a strong turnout, including students, staff, community members, SD43 Board members, and Port Coquitlam Council representatives.

We are grateful for the thoughtful comments shared both during the event and through the online form. Overall, the response has been very positive. We would like to take this opportunity to provide some additional clarity on a few common themes that emerged.

Heating, Ventilation and Cooling

The school design includes a modern heating and cooling system; however, it is not a traditional full air conditioning system. The building will be served by a combination of central and localized HVAC systems. In the gym, an air handling unit will provide ventilation and conditioned air (heating and cooling). Three central air-source heat pumps will generate hot and chilled water for the main school, which will be distributed to unit ventilators located in each classroom and teaching space. Outside air will be brought in, mixed with indoor air, and heated or cooled before being supplied to each space.

In addition, the Neighbourhood Learning Centre (NLC) will have its own dedicated system, allowing it to operate independently when needed. This approach is consistent with the design of our newer schools and recent additions across the district.

SD43 Standards for General Security in Design

Safety and security are key considerations in the design of the new school. The plans include standard features used across SD43, such as security roll shutters and the infrastructure to support the district's mobile camera system. In addition, the design process includes consultation with certified Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) specialists (both RCMP and civilian), who review elements such as overall floor plan, lighting, sightlines, landscaping, and site access (trails, roadways, sidewalks) to support a safe and welcoming environment.

We truly appreciate the ongoing engagement and support of the Hazel Trembath community and look forward to welcoming students, staff, and families into the new school.
