## **SHARE Food Bank Donation Drive**

HME has a wonderful history of donating tons of food to our local SHARE Food bank. This year, SHARE has asked us to do things a little differently. Even though they receive large quantities of food, there are some very real challenges with food drives throughout the community, including:

- Large quantities of damaged or expired food being donated and then ending up in the landfill
- A mismatch between items most needed by those who use the food bank and items donated
- Large amounts of non-perishable or less nutritious foods being donated, versus SHARE's current focus providing meat, milk, eggs, fruit, and vegetables to the families visiting the food bank

When SHARE receives monetary donations, they use those funds to buy items in bulk (increased purchase power of every dollar donated) and focus on what is most needed by those they serve every day (meal supplements for seniors, perishable foods, infant formula, and culturally appropriate items for everyone).

Starting in December (with more information coming soon), HME will embark on a new way of giving to our local food bank. We will be collecting cash (coins and bills) at school as well as online. There will be information sent home to the school community, as well as reminders in planners during the month of December. We will update our students regularly with our growing tally, and likely have information in the hallway and on announcements regarding what we've collected.

Please plan to attend **ONE** of our Winter Concerts. All students will be part of our Winter Concert. We are offering two identical concerts. Because of gym capacity concerns, we ask that you attend only one concert. All concerts will begin at **1:00pm** (Doors open at 12:30pm). # <u>Winter Weather</u>

As a general expectation, parents are to be advised that schools are open. If parents believe the local conditions are unsafe, they may keep their child at home or arrange his/her early dismissal. If schools are to be closed before morning classes begin, an announcement will be made by 6:30 a.m. on the school district website, school websites.

Announcements will be made on local radio stations CKNW (980), and CKWX (1130) by 6:30 a.m. if possible. During the full day closure, all district organized transportation of students will be cancelled. Wherever possible, the decision will be announced the previous day to enable parents more time to make alternate arrangements for their children.

- Always have your child well prepared to go outside with proper winter weather gear (Warm jacket, boots, gloves, toque, umbrella).
- On days where the school grounds are very icy and dangerous for walking, we may need to change the play areas or have the students stay inside for safety.
- Please use caution walking to school. We make sure to dour best to clear and salt a walking path, but proper footwear is essential.
- When driving, please remember to plan ahead and use patience when entering the drop off lane because of slippery conditions, and watching for pedestrians leaving and entering vehicles.
