All group 1 scholarship require the package to be completed. Group 2 are separate application forms. If you are applying for anything requiring financial need you **MUST** complete a financial need form.

- You require a reference letter from someone other than a teacher, your SIN, a copy of your transcripts and a personal letter. Also, please ensure you complete the application fully (including name on each page). We need to know who you are and how you meet scholarship criteria. Give details.
- For District Authority Awards – you may apply for as many as you are qualified but you can only win one. You require a separate page for each DAA you wish to apply for and each page requires its own specialty area nominator. Extra pages are on the website too.

Deadline for completed packages is 3:30pm Friday April 12, 2019 to Ms. Butler. Late or incomplete applications will **not** be considered.
