





#### Scholarship Alert for Grade 11 students!!!

The Horatio Alger Association of Canada, the nation's largest provider of need-based scholarships, announced the opening of its undergraduate scholarship application process on December 1. Students currently in grade 11 who will begin their university studies in the fall of 2023 are invited to submit their applications.

## NOW AVAILABLE FOR GRADE 11 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS APPLICATION OPENS DECEMBER 2021

The Horatio Alger Association is shifting the focus of its National Entrepreneurial and Canadian scholarship programs to award Grade 11 high school students beginning with the application process in 2021.

#### Why are you making this switch?

We believe that early identification and support is key to helping promising young people who have faced adversity achieve their dream of a university education. By selecting Grade 11 students, we will be able to assist with university selection, financial aid, and many more skills such as time management, self-efficacy in learning, and emotional health.

#### Is anything else changing?

The Association is still looking to award students who have demonstrated integrity, determination in overcoming adversity, academic potential, and who aspire to make a unique contribution to society.

#### What does this mean for me?

We ask that you begin to identify promising students who just finished Grade 10 and are interested in pursuing a university bachelor's degree. The application will open in December of 2021 (rather than in August as it has in past years). Selection for this scholarship program will be in the spring of the student's Grade 11 year.

The Association will continue to administer several vocational and technical scholarship programs targeted at high school Grade 12 students.
